Bethel Township | Berks County | 2020

Project Overview

Bethel Township, Berks County is a rural area with many roads that have been “built up” over the years. These



types of roads often do not get the adequate base needed to support the road structure. For this neighborhood, Bethel Township reinvested in the existing pavement & subbase through Full Depth Reclamation (FDR) with cement.

Problem Solved

A road with severe potholes, fatigue cracking, and soft spots show signs of base failure. Full Depth Reclamation allows for the existing material to be pulverized & the addition of cement builds strength with the existing materials.

Specifics & Technicalities

For this project, a 10” FDR was performed with Portland Cement.

Moving Forward

These roads have now structurally sound base & subbase to last 25 years. Adequate cross slope was established to promote proper drainage.
